Image Conditions Synergy

During activities of Study Association Synergy, photos and/or videos (hereafter "images") are taken. These images can show anyone that is present at the activity, both members and non-members. Synergy attempts to protect your privacy. This form will inform you on where Synergy's pictures can appear. These conditions apply to the services Synergy provides. The association takes care that your personal data are handled safely.

1. Website

The images that are made during activities are uploaded on the website of Synergy. These images are secured by an account with a password. Only members have an account and thus can view the images. Therefore, the images are not publicly accessible, only for members of Synergy. The pictures are filtered and checked before they are placed on the website. The pictures remain on the website for a maximum of six years.

2. (Social) media

Images can also be used on the social media channels of Synergy. The social media channels are: Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, LinkedIn and YouTube. Pictures may also be used in the Synergy magazine and in the almanac. The social media channels, the Synergy magazine and the almanac are publicly accessible. These pictures are placed permanently.

Pictures may be placed on the website, social media channels, Synergy magazine and almanac automatically, unless objections are made by the member. Objections can also be made after the pictures are placed, in which case pictures will be deleted. Objections can be made by contacting the board of Synergy, via board@synergy.nu.

3. Archive

All images are saved on cloud services and may be saved on the website database and Synergy's external hard drive(s). These images are only accessible by the board, therefore not publicly available. The images are saved for the archive to retain images of Synergy's history. The board may grant (temporary) access to the archive if necessary. For use of these images, the Image Conditions detailed in this document are applicable.
